

Children and Young People's Partnership – Rationale for Deciding Priorities and Setting Targets

Introduction

The method agreed and used by the Children and Young People's Partnership to develop the Children and Young People's Plan and the rationale for our joint local aspirations, joint local priority outcomes and joint measures is detailed below. Our targets for 2008/2011 will be agreed following the consultation process on our plan.

Rationale

The following method was used:

- Multi - agency data group established to collate needs and service information on behalf of the partnership to inform the development of the needs analysis
- Needs service data collated using core aim templates
- Service information collated using a questionnaire and an analysis tool
- Needs analysis and service profile verified amended and updated by core aim champions and core aim working groups
- Management group considered information at development day
- Partnership day held attended by all partnerships to consider early findings
- Interviews held with key partners to receive feedback on early findings
- Further analysis undertaken under each core aim and presented to Children and Young People's Partnership at development day and joint local aspirations, joint local priority outcomes and joint measures agreed
- Draft plan developed and approved by individual partner organisations, the Children and Young People's Partnership, and by the Local Authority
