

European Parliamentary Voter Registration

If you are a citizen of one of the European Union (EU) countries listed below, and are resident in the UK, you can register to vote in the UK at a European Parliamentary election.

If you are a citizen of the Republic of Ireland, Malta or Cyprus, you are eligible to register to vote at all UK elections and so **do not** need to use this form.

You may already be on the Register of Electors as a local government elector, however to be able to vote in the European Parliamentary Election in the UK you must fill in a separate registration form.

You cannot vote at the European Parliamentary elections in more than one country. If you fill in this form, you are agreeing to vote in the UK only and **not** in your home country. But remember, you can cancel this registration up until 7 May 2019.

If you intend to vote in the European Parliamentary elections in your home country rather than the UK, **do not** complete this form.

Each European Union citizen is required to complete a separate form should they wish to apply to be able to vote at the next European Parliamentary Election on 23 May 2019.

The European Parliamentary Election Registration Form must reach our office by the **7 May 2019**.

Important:

- As a citizen of an EU country you will not be able to vote at any UK General Election but completion of the European Parliamentary Election Registration Form will enable you to vote at the next European Parliamentary Election.
- Even if you are on the Register of Electors as a local government elector, you will need to fill in the separate registration form to be able to vote in the European Parliamentary Election in the UK.
