

I/we agree:

- When possible my child/children must be cared for in their own home, we understand that home is the safest place for our child/children.
- That our application for funding is in respect of our pre-school aged child/children only.
- Childcare should only be used when there is no other alternative to childcare for our child/children. If there is a parent/carer at home, then the child must remain at home to be cared for.
- To only use registered childcare provision - Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW).
- Inform our setting that we have been approved for the Coronavirus Childcare Assistance Scheme and we will provide the setting with a copy of our confirmation.
- That the daily cost will include all meals and snacks, any other service that is required must be agreed by NPT Council and the Childcare provider for example, transport.
- To inform both NPT Council and our chosen childcare provider if we no longer require childcare to be funded by the Coronavirus Assistance Scheme and where possible a 2 week notice period should be provided.

We understand:

- NPT Council will pay our chosen childcare provider directly for booked days agreed until June 2020.
- The Welsh Government have made available the Coronavirus funding until June, subject to review by the Welsh Government.
- The funding is for pre-school children only for those parents who are keyworkers.
- Critical workers who have children of school age should continue to send their children to a school setting.
- In some cases, we may be able to support older siblings to attend the same setting as their pre-school siblings. This will be treated on an individual basis.
- The childcare setting will still receive childcare payments if your child is not present due to Covid-19 symptoms or not present due to living with someone within the household who has Covid-19 symptoms.
