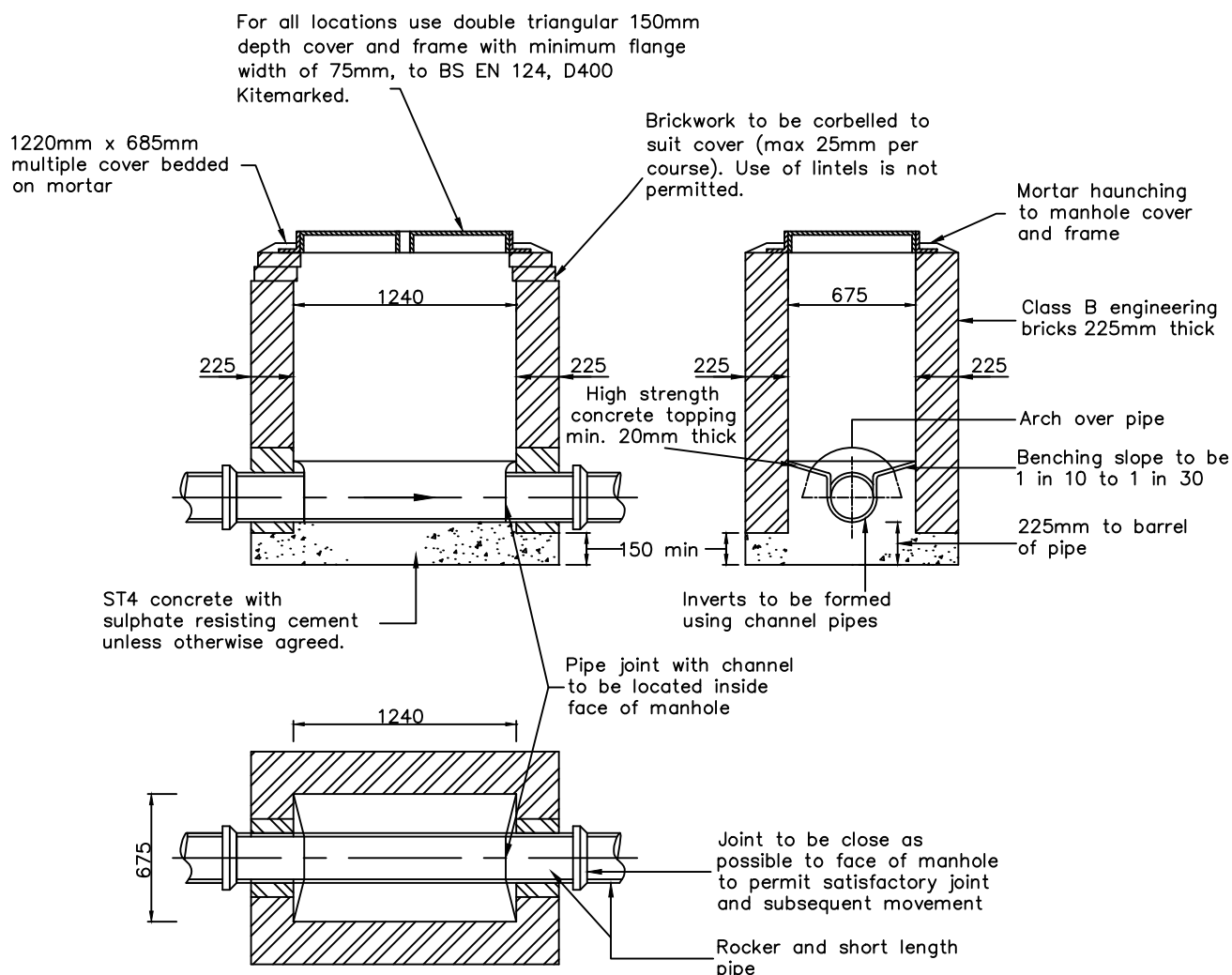

**NOTES**

1. All dimensions are in millimetres unless otherwise stated.
2. Brickwork manholes should be a last case scenario and where the chamber height is less than 900mm and a Type B manhole can not be used, a Type F manhole will be considered as an alternative.
3. For Type C manholes, the internal dimensions are normally 1240 x 675, but manhole width should be increased for pipes larger than 225 diameter to give 225 benching each side with the brickwork corbelled down to suit cover.
