

**GATING ORDER - SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**  
**COUNTY BOROUGH OF NEATH & PORT TALBOT (ALLEYWAYS IN THE**  
**ABERAVON AREA, PORT TALBOT) ORDER 2008**

The Neath & Port Talbot County Borough Council, in exercise of its power under Section 129A(1) of the Highways Act 1980 and of all other enabling powers and being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A(3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 (the "Alleyways") on the Plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any person who lives in premises adjoining the Alleyways, Council employees or Council contractors or to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Alleyways.
3. Barriers may be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Alleyways. The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. 4. The alternative routes for pedestrians and vehicular traffic which are provided for each of the Alleyways due to the restrictions imposed on the Alleyways are those indicated in the Schedule below and marked with dotted lines on the Plan annexed to this Order.
5. This Order shall take effect on the date hereof.

**SCHEDULE**

**Alleyways to be gated**

1. Alleyway to the rear of Lilian Street and Thomas Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From No.2 Lilian Street to No 28 Lilian Street (a distance of Approximately 155 metres) – shown marked '1' on the plan.  
Ordinance Survey reference : **A** – SS 756 900 ; **B** – SS 756 899  
Alternative route – Lilian Street.

2. Alleyway to the rear of Corporation Road and Leslie Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Bailey Street to the junction with Dunraven Street. (a distance of Approximately 115 metres) – shown marked '2' on the plan.  
Ordnance Survey Reference: **A** – SS 759 900 ; **B** – SS 760 900  
Alternative routes – Corporation Road
3. Alleyway to the rear of Leslie Street and Olive Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Bailey Street to the junction with Dunraven Street. (a distance of Approximately 115 metres) – shown marked '3' on the plan.  
Ordnance Survey Reference: **A** – SS 759 901 ; **B** – SS760 900  
Alternative routes – Leslie Street
4. Alleyway to the rear of Olive Street and Arthur Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Bailey Street to the junction with Dunraven Street. (a distance of Approximately 120 metres) – shown marked '4' on the plan.  
Ordnance Survey Reference: **A** – SS 759 901 ; **B** – SS 760 901  
Alternative route – Olive Street
5. Alleyway to the rear of Arthur Street and Alexandra Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Bailey Street to the junction with Dunraven Street. (a distance of Approximately 120 metres) – shown marked '5' on the plan.  
Ordnance Survey Reference: **A** – SS 760 902 ; **B** – SS 761 901  
Alternative access routes – Arthur Street
6. Alleyway to the rear of Alexandra Street and Gwendoline Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Bailey Street to the junction with Dunraven Street. (a distance of Approximately 115 metres) – shown marked '6' on the plan.  
Ordnance Survey Reference: **A** – SS 760 902 ; **B** – SS 761 902  
Alternative access routes – Alexandra Street
7. Alleyway to the rear of Gwendoline Street and John Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Bailey Street to the junction with Dunraven Street. (a distance of Approximately 115 metres) – shown marked '7' on the plan.  
Ordnance Survey Reference: **A** – SS 760 903 ; **B** – SS761 902  
Alternative Access routes – Gwendoline Street
8. Alleyway to the rear of John Street and New Street, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Knight Street to the junction with Dunraven Street. (a distance of Approximately 115 metres) – shown marked '8' on the plan.  
Ordnance Survey Reference: **A** – SS 760 903 ; **B** – SS 761 903  
Alternative access routes – John Street
9. Alleyway to the rear of Beach Street, Ysguthan Road, Pembroke Terrace and Sandfields Road, Aberavon, Port Talbot.  
From the junction with Ysguthan Road to No. 22 Beach Street. (a distance of Approximately 105 metres) – shown marked '9' on the plan.

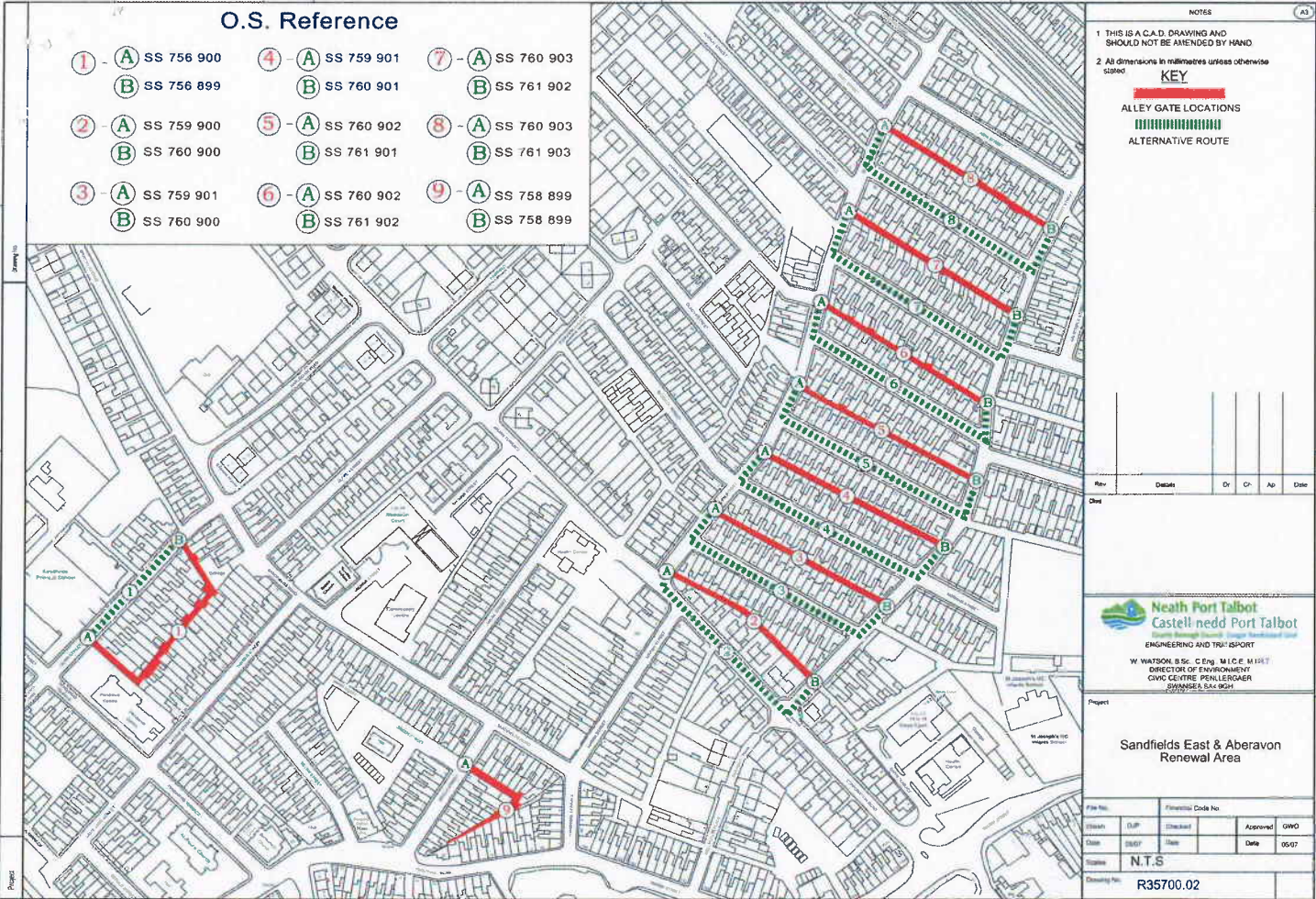
