Pedestrian improvement works in Coed Darcy, Skewen and Neath Abbey

Background

- The pedestrian and cycling routes linking Coed Darcy to Neath fail to provide accessible or adequate infrastructure for residents, including those with disabilities.
- The pedestrian footways connecting lower Skewen to Neath Abbey require infrastructure upgrades to comply with accessibility standards for residents with disabilities and parents with pushchairs.
- Coed Darcy was originally envisioned as a self-sustaining development complete with its own schools and retail; however, until these materialise, residents remain dependent on external infrastructure.

Background (continued)

- A funding bid has been submitted to the Welsh Government's Regional Transport Fund to enhance pedestrian footways extending from Coed Darcy through Skewen and into Neath Abbey.

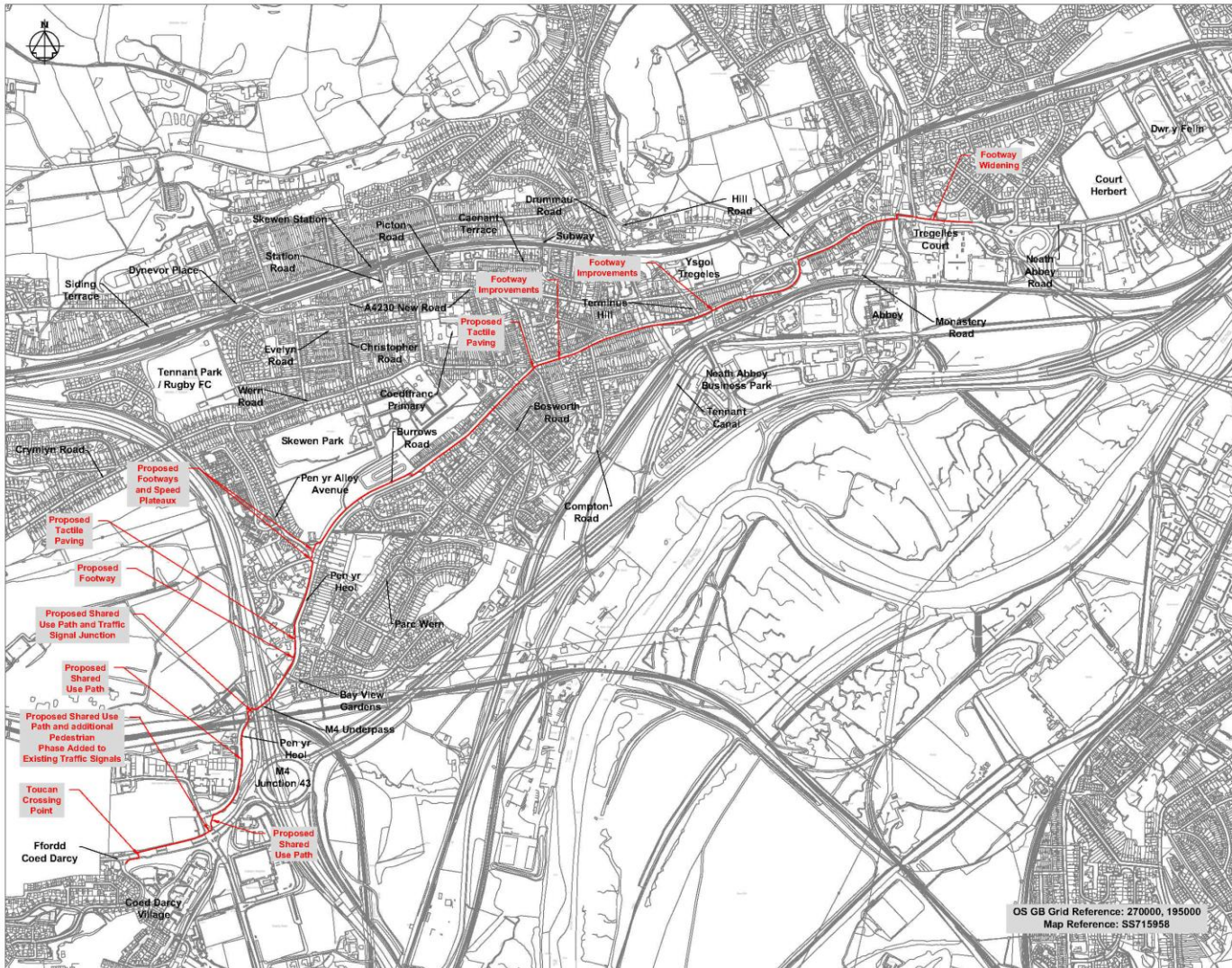
